#### **Ephesians 2:10 (NLT)**

For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago.

### **PREPARE YOURSELF**

- Set yourself apart for God.

#### **Joshua 3:5 (NIV)**

#### **Isaiah 54:2-3 (NLT)**

"Enlarge your house; build an addition. Spread out your home, and spare no expense! 3 For you will soon be bursting at the seams..."

#### **Galatians 5:25**

Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.

**Galatians 5:16 (NIV)**

So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh.

“Walk” is the Greek word peripateite: “to walk around after someone or to walk in a particular direction”

**Galatians 5:17–18 (NIV)**

For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want. <sup>18</sup> But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.

**Galatians 5:19–23 (NIV)**

The acts of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; <sup>20</sup> idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions <sup>21</sup> and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God. <sup>22</sup> But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

**Galatians 5:24–25 (NIV)**

Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. <sup>25</sup> Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.

**Galatians 5:25 (NLT)**

Since we are living by the Spirit, let us follow the Spirit’s leading in every part of our lives.

There is a corporate harmony and togetherness in this pursuit of keeping in step with the Spirit! Like an army platoon marching in step with their leader together!

**PREPARE YOURSELF**

We are to consecrate ourselves to God!

**Joshua 3:5 (NIV)**

Joshua told the people, “Consecrate yourselves, for tomorrow the LORD will do amazing things among you.”

Consecration means “the separation of oneself from things that are unclean - anything that would contaminate one’s relationship with a perfect God.”

**Acts 3:19–20 (NLT)**

Now repent of your sins and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped away. <sup>20</sup> Then times of refreshment will come from the presence of the Lord, and he will again send you Jesus, your appointed Messiah.

**James 4:7–8 (NLT)**

So humble yourselves before God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. <sup>8</sup> Come close to God, and God will come close to you. Wash your hands, you sinners; purify your hearts, for your loyalty is divided between God and the world.
